

ASEE 2nd Annual Student Video Contest

Official Contest Rules

The American Society for Engineering Education (ASEE) invites undergraduate, graduate and post-doctoral students to submit a 90-second video answering the question: *Why are you pursuing a degree or career in the engineering profession?*

Important Dates

Registration Opens: December 5, 2019

Registration Closes: 11:59PM EST February 28, 2020

Submission Deadline for all Videos: 11:59PM EST March 6, 2020

Judging Period: March 7 – April 3, 2020

Winners Announced: April 10, 2020

First Place will be awarded at the ASEE Annual Conference in Montreal, Canada in June 2020

Contest Eligibility

Use your creativity as you answer the posed question: *Why are you pursuing a degree or career in the engineering profession?* This contest is open to individuals who reside in the fifty United States, including the District of Columbia, and territories and possessions of the United States, ages 18 and older. Full-time students residing in Canada will also be considered. All contestants must be full-time students currently enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate or post-doctoral program at an accredited college or university. Contest is void where prohibited.

Contestants may work in teams of up to four individuals. To be considered for this contest, all participants are required to complete and sign any necessary release and waiver forms. One person shall be named the Spokesperson and is responsible for all submissions.

Full Rules and Information

ASEE invites undergraduate, graduate and post-doctoral students, attending an accredited college or university to create a video answering the question: *Why are you pursuing a degree or career in the engineering profession?*

To enter, access the official contest website: www.contest.asee.org during the contest period, complete the required registration application and submit to contest@asee.org alongside all required release and waiver forms, as directed.

Videos may only include authorized content, music, images or film clips. Entries must be successfully submitted no later than 11:59PM EST on March 6, 2020.

Limit of one (1) entry per person or team. Entries become property of ASEE and will neither be acknowledged nor returned.

A qualified committee of judges will select a first, second and third place winner, which will then be posted on the ASEE website and social media pages. There will be a limit of one (1) vote per person. If

there is an event of a tie in voting, the tied videos will be judged by our selected committee. Winners will be individually notified by the provided email address or telephone number no later than April 10, 2020. The selected ASEE judging committee will publicly announce the contest winners no later than April 10, 2020.

Prizes & Requirements

The first-place winner will receive a \$3,000 cash prize, the second-place winner will receive a \$1,500 cash prize and the third-place winner will receive a \$500 cash prize.

In addition to the cash prize, the first-place winner will receive a trip which consists of two (2) tickets for coach airfare from the major airport nearest the winner's residence in the US to the ASEE Annual Conference in Montreal, Canada, two-night hotel accommodations (double room), ground transportation, and meals during the length of stay. Should the winner not attend the annual conference trip, the winner shall not be entitled to any cash or other compensation in lieu thereof. No substitution may be given in place of the prize.

Winners will be responsible for paying taxes on prizes, including cash prizes, and any expenses not specified relating to the acceptance and use of a prize. An IRS Form 1099 will be issued to winners where applicable. ASEE may reserve the right to contact the winner's school directly.

Each winner will be required to provide a copy of a valid photo ID (driver's license, passport or other form of identification which includes proof of age); and evidence of enrollment as a student. Failure to return the required documents in a timely manner, or the return of any notification as undeliverable for any reason, will cause the entry to be void and an alternate winner to be selected.

By participating, entrants must agree to these official rules and to the decisions of the judges and ASEE and its agents in all matters, including the voting process relating to the contest which decisions shall be final in all respects; release, indemnify and hold harmless ASEE, their respective directors, officers and employees, from any and all claims, liabilities, losses or damages of any kind whatsoever, including but not limited to the infringement of intellectual property rights of others, resulting in whole or in part from their participation in the contest and the acceptance and use of the prize; consent to the use of their name, likeness and location for advertising and publicity purposes by ASEE, in its sole discretion, of its products and services and for promotion of the importance of protection of intellectual property rights; and represent that the video submitted is their sole and original work and does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any other party.

In the event that ASEE determines that the integrity of the contest has been impaired or corrupted for any reason and as a result cannot be offered or completed as planned, ASEE reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel or terminate the contest. Dates are subject to change.
